

EBE408 Gender and Midwifery

Course Description: This course explores theories related to gender and their implications in the context of midwifery, addressing attitudes toward gender roles, factors influencing these attitudes, and the societal reflections of gender roles. The course also examines the intersection of reproductive health, gender, and the current state of gender discrimination globally and in Turkey. The role of midwives in the context of gender discrimination is discussed, and students engage in group activities and presentations.

- Gain a comprehensive understanding of gender theories and their application in midwifery, contributing to efforts toward gender equality in healthcare.
- Critically analyze and address gender-related factors influencing reproductive health, fostering inclusivity and reducing inequalities in healthcare practices.
- Advocate for the role of midwives in combating gender discrimination and promoting positive societal changes related to gender roles and reproductive health.
