Course Description: This course aims to equip students with the skills to understand the activities of various groups within society, identify the functioning and challenges of associations, institutions, universities, schools, and charitable organizations. Teacher candidates will engage in observations and interviews to gain a general understanding of the school, association, charitable institution, and facility where they will conduct their practical training. The course provides opportunities for teacher candidates to research and contribute to the resolution of health and education-related issues in the community. These activities enable candidates to better understand the community, acclimate to their working environment, and apply the knowledge gained over four years of study.

Course Outcomes:

- Learn about the activities of various groups in society.
- Identify the functioning and challenges of associations, institutions, universities, schools, and charitable organizations.
- Contribute to solving problems within community groups.
- Overcome potential problems during the problem-solving process.
- Identify issues threatening community health.
