Course Description: This course focuses on the properties of open-seed plants, including pine trees and undergrowths, without delving into them. It defines their ecological needs, growth ambience, natural distribution, and dispersal mechanisms, along with exploring aesthetic, architectural, and landscape potentials for sustainable applications.

Course Outcomes:

- Students will apply sustainable practices in selecting and utilizing open-seed plant materials, considering their ecological needs, promoting biodiversity, and contributing to responsible landscape management.
- Participants will analyze and integrate the aesthetic and architectural potentials of open-seed plants into landscape designs, fostering environmentally conscious and visually appealing outdoor spaces.
